In compliance with the decision of the Porto General Assembly, the Executive Committee of INAS Europe began work on revising our Constitution. For this purpose we had the invaluable contribution of Dr Maria Dranikova and Dr. Yossi Romano who worked with us on pro bono as legal advisers.

Also noteworthy was the the availability of General Director Nick Parr who went to Istanbul to participate in the constitutional review.

This is therefore a collective work of the EC of INAS Europe and collaborators.

The attached document is our proposal that will be send for approval at an **Extraordinary General Assembly that will take place in Madrid on September 6 and 7, 2019.**

This document is for your consideration and you can request the clarifications that you deem necessary.

Proposals for amendments should take the form of a motion to be voted in the GA. These **motions should be addressed to Mireille Segerie (mireille.segerie@ffsa.asso.fr) by June 30, 2019.**

It is clear from the new Constitution of INAS World that the Regions have the right to vote and to send motions to the General Assembly, having to apply for membership and being obliged to pay an annual fee proportional to the number of members to be nominated for the Governing Board. This process is also over and awaits formal approval at the next Governing Board meeting on 2 May in Hong Kong.
